The establishment and growth of VFAHT

2016

This year marked the founding of VFAHT at the CM Secretariat, Punjab by an association of Pakistani doctors from North America and medical peers in Pakistan.

• 2017

- Focus was placed to spread awareness about hepatitis among different institutions and conduction of screening camps within the local councils

- Significant increase in volunteers were seen by the end of this year to support the cause

• 2018

- The coming of the year brought in 4 more institutions under the VFAHT council

• 2019

- The sudden outbreak of Hepatitis E and typhoid led to the introduction of the infectious disease department.
- 2 new local councils were also founded making a total of 18 councils around the nation

• 2020

- VFAHT currently has 4 major domains which covers 10 infectious diseases with COVID-19 being the latest addition.

Objectives

- To increase the level of public awareness about the prevention of infectious diseases by community campaigns.
- To build the capacity of undergraduate students (medical, dental, and others) to carry out awareness campaigns.
- To promote the micro-elimination of infectious diseases by organizing testing and vaccination camps.
- To promote the culture of research by organizing original research studies and surveys.
