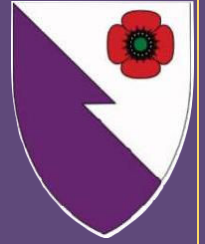

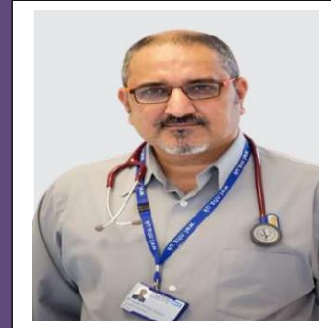

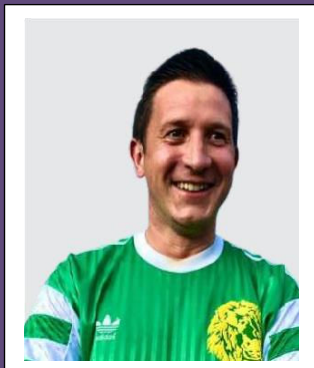

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES DURING VISIT BY RCEM DELEGATION

DAY-1

A delegation of Royal College of Emergency Medicine(RCEM) visited Pakistan from from 25th November 2022 to 1st od December 2022. Delegation comprised of

- Mr. Andrew Fryer(International Manager RCEM)

On 27th November , delegation paid a visit to Rawalpindi Medical University's main campus. After arrival at 6.30pm, President RCEM held a meeting with Lead Educational Supervisor and educational / clinical supervisors. This meeting was followed by a formal feedback session with the trainees of Emergency Medicine Foundation Program(EMFP), batch 1 and batch 2.

After this feedback session with trainees, delegation attended certificate distribution ceremony followed by Gala Dinner.

DAY-2

On day 2, 28th November 2022, delegation visited new teaching block of RMU in Holy Family Hospital. President Royal College of Emergency Medicine –UK, Dr Adrian Boyle addressed final year students of MBBS in RMU. After this session delegation visited department of emergency medicine and center of liver diseases in Holy Family Hospital.
